Difficult Cases in Holistic Veterinary Medicine

Dr. Sagiv Ben-Yakir, veterinarian and biologist, is licensed to practice veterinary medicine in Israel, USA, Canada and UK. He is not only member and teacher but also certified by international organisations such as IVAS, AHVMA, AVMA, IBS etc. (See also the attached Curriculum vitae). He has lectured and published a lot about his clinical experiences. His over 20 years continuous practice in small, large, equine & exotic animals using both conventional and holistic medicine turned him an internationally recognized teacher, whose skills are of interest to the entire world.

In 2008 he lectured in the two biggest US Congresses, the North American Veterinary Conference (NAVC), in the American Veterinary Medical Association (AVMA) Conference and in the "Second Academic Conference of the Asia Society of Traditional Veterinary Medicine" in Taipei University, Taiwan. The lecture there, about veterinary acupuncture, was held in front of Asian veterinarians coming from China, Taiwan, Japan, Korea, Singapore etc. Dr. Ben-Yakir is the first veterinarian ever teaching acupuncture modalities to this very academic Far East audience. In September 08, Dr. Sagiv Ben-Yakir lectured about gold beads implantation in acupuncture points on "The International Veterinary Acupuncture Society" (IVAS) International Congress in Colorado, USA in front of a worldwide international veterinarian audience. It is the fifth consecutive congress where Dr. Ben-Yakir lectured for this international audience.

After Dr Ben Yakir's 2-days seminar at Équilibre in November 2008, we will now offer this practical and didactically brilliant seminar in a three-day course in order to allow more time for questions, answers and discussion on the topics.

Dr. Sagiv Ben-Yakir is a sympathetic, open minded clinician who shares his knowledge in a well understandable way.
